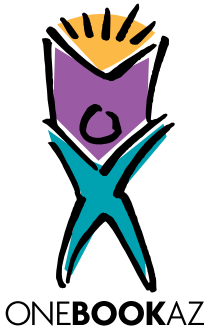
For The Visually Impaired

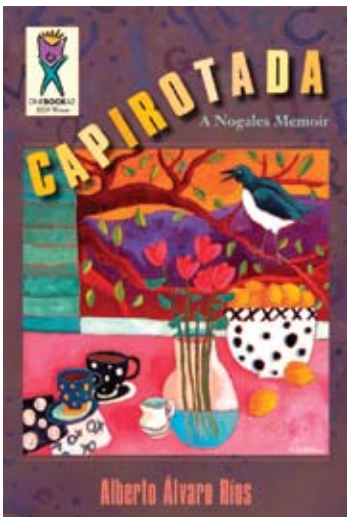

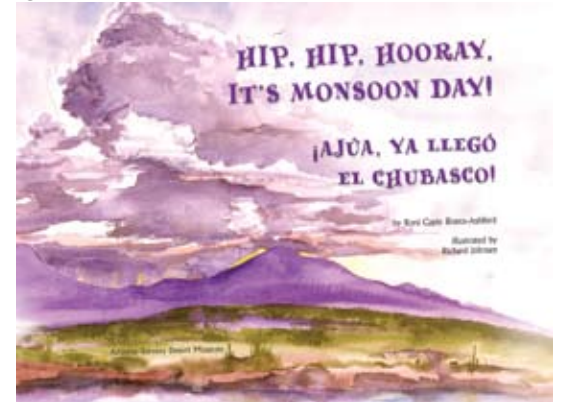
